No-Fault PIP Choice: Starting July 2, 2020, drivers can choose one of the following levels of No-Fault PIP medical benefits coverage: \$500,000; \$250,000; \$50,000; and "no limit."

Savings for drivers: For auto insurance policies effective after July 1, 2020 (and before Alison F. Duffy July 1, 2028), drivers will save the following amounts depending on which of the No-Fault caps above they choose: 20%; 35%; 45%; 10%.

Michigan Catastrophic Claims Association: The MCCA will continue to pay medical benefits for catastrophically injured car crash victims based on policies issued or renewed before July 2, 2020.
