

## CAR ACCIDENT INJURY SURVIVOR SCHOLARSHIP

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident,
- Have sustained injuries from an auto accident at some point in your life,
- Be <u>currently</u> enrolled (as of December 31, 2021) as a full or part time student in an accredited college or university within the United States,
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

The following documents must be provided for consideration:

- A completed application,
- A copy of a current academic transcript with both the student and college name,
- Copy of the police report from your accident. If a copy cannot be obtained from the
  police department or from their online system, other forms of acceptable proof can be a
  report from your auto insurance company, or a medical or physical therapy
  document. Any document instead of a police report must include your name and list that
  your injuries were from an auto accident,
- A typed essay of not more than three pages describing the accident, your injuries, and how you have overcome your injuries while pursuing a college education.

The award recipient shall provide the following documentation to obtain the scholarship:

- Proof of Legal Residency in U.S. (i.e. drivers license, passport, permanent resident card, etc.)
- The Michigan Auto Law scholarship is to be used exclusively for college tuition and related expenses. A check for \$500 will be made payable to the award recipient's school to cover these expenses and he or she is expected to submit receipts in accordance with IRS regulations

#### **AWARD**

Two applicants will be awarded a \$500 scholarship in 2022. The Michigan Auto Law Scholarship award recipient will be notified of the selection on or before April 1st, 2022.

#### **DEADLINE**

Completed applications must be submitted no later than **December 31**<sup>st</sup>, **2021**.
