CAR ACCIDENT INJURY SURVIVOR SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident,
- Have innocently sustained injuries from a car or truck accident at some point in your life (i.e., you were not at-fault in causing and/or contributing to the accident that resulted in your injuries)
- Be <u>currently</u> enrolled (as of December 31, 2023) as a full or part time student in an accredited college or university within the United States,
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.

REQUIREMENTS

The following documents must be provided for consideration:

- A completed application,
- A copy of a current academic transcript with both the student and college name,
- Copy of the police report from your accident. If a copy cannot be obtained from the police department or from their online system, other forms of acceptable proof can be a report from your auto insurance company, or a medical or physical therapy document. Any document instead of a police report must include your name and list that your injuries were from an auto accident,
- A typed essay of not more than three pages describing the accident, your injuries, and how you have overcome your injuries while pursuing a college education.

The award recipient shall provide the following documentation to obtain the scholarship:

- Proof of Legal Residency in U.S. (i.e. drivers license, passport, permanent resident card, etc.)
- The Michigan Auto Law scholarship is to be used exclusively for college tuition and related expenses. A check for \$1000 will be made payable to the award recipient's school to cover these expenses and he or she is expected to submit receipts in accordance with IRS regulations

AWARD

One applicant will be awarded one \$1,000 scholarship in 2024. The Michigan Auto Law Scholarship award recipient will be notified of the selection on or before April 1st, 2024.

DEADLINE
